**Alexander Johan (Alex) de Voogt**, a Dutch [psychologist](#), curator in African [Ethnology](#) at [American Museum of Natural History](#) <sup>[1]</sup>, until 2009 assistant professor at [Leiden](#) and [Maastricht University](#). De Voogt researched and published on diverse topics as [seventh century Islam](#), [Nubian architecture](#), and the [history of writing systems](#) <sup>[2]</sup>, and is renowned [Mancala](#) game researcher holding a Ph.D. on [Bao](#) mastership from [Leiden University](#) <sup>[3]</sup>. He is member of the International Society for *Board Game Studies* <sup>[4]</sup> and is editor of its journal <sup>[5]</sup>.
