Anatoli,

a [WinBoard](#) compliant chess engine by [Martin Giepmans](#), first released in April 2008 and freely available via [Leo Dijkman's WBEC Ridderkerk](#) site ^[1]. Like Martin's earlier engine [SpiderChess](#), Anatoli is written in [Delphi](#). Martin named it after [Anatoly Karpov](#) (Dutch [transliteration Anatoli Karpov](#)) ^[2] because he admired Karpov's subtle playing style and had the hope he might teach Anatoli to play a bit like Karpov, though ^{[3] [4]}.
