BBchess,

a chess program by [Bernard Brioit](#). The engine part is written in [Pascal](#), its own [GUI](#) in [Delphi](#). BBchess uses the [0x88 Board representation](#) and performs an improved [MTD\(f\) search](#) on top of [iterative deepening](#) and applies [Null move pruning](#) with a [depth reduction](#) of 3. It uses two [transposition tables](#), and supports the [Thompson endgame databases](#) with three and four pieces ^[1].
