### Chat,

[Wolfgang Delmare's](#) first chess program, playing the [WCCC 1986](#), [WMCCC 1987](#) and [WMCCC 1988](#) <sup>[1]</sup>. Chat was written in [Pascal](#), typically running as [DOS](#) engine with a [command line interface](#), at the [WCCC 1986](#) on a [CDC Cyber 175](#), at the [WMCCC 1988](#) as [dedicated unit](#) on a [68020](#) processor with a [SciSys Leonardo](#) board <sup>[2] [3]</sup> as [user interface](#) <sup>[4] [5]</sup>. According to [Thorsten Czub](#), Chat had only a [brute-force search depth](#) of one [ply](#), but was otherwise quite [selective](#) <sup>[6]</sup>.
