Chess, (CC)

a series of commercial chess programs written by [David Thompson](#) in [6502 assembly](#) for [Acorn home computers](#), [Commodore 64](#) and [Oric computers](#). Chess **1.12** was published in 1981 for the [Acorn Atom](#), released by [Acornsoft](#) (?). In 1983, Chess was released through [Computer Concepts](#) targeting the [BBC Micro](#) ^[1], while the Acornsoft Chess brand for the BBC Micro was continued with a [program](#) by [Arthur Norman](#) and [Nick Pelling](#) ^[2]. Chess was further adapted for the [Commodore 64](#) and released in 1984 by [Superior Software](#) ^[3], and by [IJK Software](#) for the [Oric-1](#) and [Oric Atmos](#) ^[4].
