Conic Korchnoi <sup>[8]</sup>

**Conic X**, (Conic Experimental, Conic 7013, Conic Korchnoi) an experimental [dedicated chess computer](#) by correspondent [Hong Kong](#) manufacturer *Conic* <sup>[1] [2] [3] [4]</sup>, with a program by [Stephen Chen](#) <sup>[5]</sup>. Conic X played the [WMCCC 1981](#) in [Travemünde](#) and became 6th of 8 with 2/7. While the tournament report by [Björn Schwarz](#) <sup>[6]</sup> mentioned Conic Experimental running on a [Z 80 A](#) CPU, the soon later released *Conic 7013* endorsed by [Victor Korchnoi](#), with magnetic [sensory board](#) and apparently a similar program <sup>[7]</sup>, was shipped with a [6502](#) processor.
