Corel Chess, a commercial [Windows multimedia](#) chess program based on the chess engine [Socrates](#) by [Don Dailey](#) and [Larry Kaufman](#), produced and published by [Corel](#) in 1995. The Corel Chess project was lead by [Alexander G. M. Smith](#) ^[1], who further developed the [GUI](#) with animation player spooling [sound](#) and [video](#) off the [CD-ROM](#) and draws it in the [3D world](#) using the Windows regular [GDI](#) and Corel's off-screen [bitmap](#) drawing code. Corel Chess features [TCP-IP](#) play that allows two users to play each other and send comments to each other without having to access a Web site ^[2].
