written in [Turbo Pascal](#). It uses a
fast, [incremental updated
evaluation](#), and applies a [principal
variation search](#) with none
recursive [null move pruning](#) of
[R=2](#), [razoring](#), and has no [Hash
tables](#) ^[1]. Diogenes played several
[International Paderborn Computer
Chess Championships](#), [Aegon
Tournaments](#) ^[2] and three [World
Microcomputer Chess
Championships](#), [Munich 1993](#),
[Paderborn 1995](#) and [Jakarta 1996](#)
^[3].
