E.T.Chess,

a chess program by [Eric Triki](#) written in [C](#). The older [DOS](#) version, developed until 2001, has its own [graphical interface](#) ^[1], applying [Negamax Alpha-Beta](#), a quite advanced [evaluation function](#), [Killer heuristic](#), [Null move heuristic](#) and a [Transposition table](#). The new version, a complete rewrite, supports the [Chess Engine Communication Protocol](#) ^{[2] [3]}.

E.T.Chess played the [Massy 2002](#) and [Massy 2004 French Programmers Tournaments](#) and the [CCT10](#).
