**EdChess**, (Ed Chess, Ed's Chess, Chess!)

a [shareware](#) chess program for the [IBM PC](#), released in 1992 by *EdTech Associates Inc.* running under [DOS](#). The program has been developed by [David Hendricks](#) supported by [John T. Bell](#) <sup>[1]</sup> over a period of three years, written entirely with [Aztec C](#) 4.1d <sup>[2]</sup>. EdChess features a [semigraphics board](#), drawing [squares](#) and [pieces](#) using IBM's [special character set](#), and applies [alpha-beta](#) within an [iterative deepening](#) loop.
