**Elegance** (Fidelity Elegance, Chess Challenger Elegance), a [dedicated chess computer](#) of the [Chess Challenger](#) series by [Fidelity Electronics](#), produced and distributed since 1984. Like the [Fidelity Elite A/S](#) the computer with a [6502](#) processor ran a [Sargon](#) based program by [Dan](#) and [Kathe Spracklen](#). Elegance had a compact, wooden [sensory board](#) with [reed switches](#) and magnets in the chessmen.

Along with his "team" members [Elite](#) and [Private Line](#), Elegance played the [4th World Microcomputer Chess Championship 1984](#) in [Glasgow](#) <sup>[1]</sup>
