Excelsior,

a [WinBoard](#) compliant chess engine by [Marek Klonowski](#), initially written in [Delphi](#), and since version 3.16 rewritten in [C#](#), which requires the [Windows .Net framework](#). Excelsior (Delphi) played the [PCCC 2003](#), released to the public in November 2004 ^[2], the C# version played the [IOPCCC 2007](#).
