a private chess programm written by [Jean-Louis Boussin](#). Futé participated at the [WCCC 2005](#) in [Reykjavík](#) and scored 0.5/11, but was the one and only program to take even a half point off of winner [Zappa](#). Futé applied the "Plan of Attack", a [pre-processing](#) technique performed at the [root](#) to control its [search](#) and [evaluation](#) <sup>[1]</sup>.
