Genesis,

a [PC](#) chess program by [Eric van Riet Paap](#) written in [C](#) and [x86 Assembly](#) to ran under [MS-DOS](#). It had a program size of 60 [KiB](#), was searching [selectively](#) with an "unlimited" [quiescence search](#), and archived about 11.500 [Nodes per second](#) on a [486](#) @ 50Mhz, one of the fast searchers in the early 90s ^[1]. Genesis participated at the [4th Computer Olympiad 1992](#) in [London](#) and won the gold medal, tied with [The King](#) and [Hiarcs 6.72](#), and further played the [DOCCC 1992](#) and co-authored by [Huib-Jan Imbens](#) as Genesis 2 the [DOCCC 1993](#), where it also played as a [parallel](#) incarnation under the name [Petunia](#), running on a [486 PC](#) controlling three [Intel i860](#) processors ^[2].
