### **Gosu,**

a chess engine by [Arkadiusz Paterek](#), originated as a part of his master thesis. In Korean its name means "expert" (let us better forget about the second, Japanese meaning of the word: "a bowl used to hold [Go](#) stones") <sup>[1]</sup>. Gosu is an unique program, because it has an evaluation function based on a [neural network](#) and plays at 2300-2400 Elo level, performing a strong [CCT7](#) with 4½/8.
