

**Grand Master**, (Grandmaster, Grandmaster Chess, Schaken, Ajedrez II)

a chess program initially developed by [Fritz Schäfer](#) <sup>[1]</sup> for the [Commodore VIC-20](#), later ported for the [Commodore 64](#) and [Commodore 16](#), and released in 1982 through Schäfer's former Homecomputer Software company *Kingsoft* <sup>[2]</sup>, and [Audiogenic](#) in the [UK](#). [The Spacious Mind](#) considers Grand Master as one of the strongest chess programs available on Home Computers at that time <sup>[3]</sup>
