Greif played the [WMCCC 1993](#) in Munich ^[1] and the [IPCCC 1994](#) and was identified by [Rainer Serfling](#) ^[2] at the end of the [Clodra](#) chess tournament in November 1994 as a [clone](#) of [Chrilly Donninger's](#) program [Nimzo 2](#) ^[3]. During a heated Rybka clone discussion in [CCC](#) Daniel Mehrmann assured to know nothing about the Greif sources ^[4].
