an [UCI](#) compliant chess engine by [Péter Horváth](#). Its development apparently started in 2009, after Péter's former engine [Asterisk](#) played the [MASPV 2009](#). Hussar **0.1** was first released in 2010. Last recent version was Hussar **0.4** released in 2011 - its original download site abandoned. Hussar is able to play [Chess960](#) and supports skill levels ^[1].
