Master Chess, (Masterchess) a chess program for [Amstrad CPC](#) by [Amsoft](#) / [Mikro-Gen](#), released in 1984, written in [Z80 machine code](#) apparently based on [ZX Spectrum Chess](#) written by [Anthony Adam](#). A program with the same name was further published in 1987 by [Mastertronic](#) for Amstrad CPC and various Z80 as well as [6502](#) based [home computers](#), such as [Atari 8-bit](#), [Commodore 64](#), [MSX](#) and [ZX Spectrum](#) ^[1].
