Mephisto MM II,

a [dedicated chess computer module](#) for [Mephisto module systems](#) by [Hegener & Glaser](#) launched in 1985 with a [Plymate](#) based program by [Ulf Rathsman](#). The Mephisto MM II ran on a [65C02](#) CPU at 3.7 MHz inside a 32 KiB [ROM](#) using 4 KiB of [RAM](#) ^[1]. Based on the MM II, the Mephisto **B&P** (Blitz- and Problemsolving) appeared in the same year ^[2].
