a [dedicated chess computer](#)
prototype build by [Rainer Serfling](#).
It consists of a [sensory board](#) and
standard [PC-hardware](#) with [80486](#)
inside, and ran a chess program
based on [Jörg Burwitz' Diogenes](#).
[Milobarus](#) played the [Aegon 1994](#)
^[1] and finished with 1½ out of 6
and three draws. The computer's
name apparently was devoted to
[strongman Milo Barus](#) (1906 -
1977), at times [innkeeper](#) of
Klosterbräu-Stübl in [Stadtroda](#) and
Meuschkensmühle in [Eisenberger](#)
[Mühlthal](#) near [Weißborn](#),
[Thuringia](#), close to Rainer
Serfling's home.
