A match between the 12 qualified for the [Dutch National Championship](#) and strong computers took place in [Hilversum](#), April 9, [1989](#), sponsored by [Philips](#) and [AVRO](#) ^[1]. Time control was 1h/60 moves + 1h and then adjudication if the game is not finished. The Dutch team won 8.5 - 3.5!
