PK80, PK83,

a series of chess programs by [Ard van Bergen](#) written in [Fortran](#). As Ard was affiliated with a chess club in [Utrecht](#) named in remembrance of [Paul Keres](#) ^[1], Keres initials were used as the name of the program.

PK80 already played the first [DOCCC 1981](#), running on a [PDP-11](#) ^[2], PK83 the [DOCCC 1982](#), the [DOCCC 1983](#) where it became shared second, the [DOCCC 1984](#), the [DOCCC 1985](#) and the [DOCCC 1987](#). PK83 further played the [International Computer Chess Tournament 1984](#) in [Baarn](#), and the [WMCCC 1985](#) in [Amsterdam](#) ^[3].

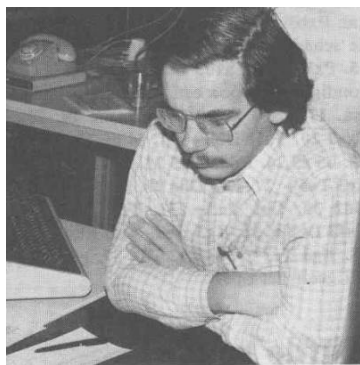
