### **Plymate,**

a series of chess programs by [Ulf Rathsmann](#) and [Lars Hjörth](#) written in [Assembly](#) to run on [6502](#) based [dedicated chess computers](#) with up to 8 MHz. Plymate was commercially marketed as [cartridge](#) for [Conchess](#) computers <sup>[4]</sup>, competing the [WCCC 1986](#) in [Cologne](#), and three micro events, the [WMCCC 1985](#), [WMCCC 1987](#) and the commercial group of the [WMCCC 1988](#). The Plymate program was further incorporated inside the [Mephisto MM II](#) by [Hegener & Glaser](#) <sup>[2]</sup>.
