first released in April 2000 ^[1], the

^[2]. At least earlier versions of
Queen used [NegaScout](#) utilizing a
[transposition table](#) storing both
[lower](#) and [upper bound scores](#) with
separate [drafts](#) but only one [best](#)
[move](#) ^[3].
