an early chess program written in [Basic](#), published in 1977 by *Tenberg Software Systems*, [Cockeysville, Maryland](#), sold on [paper tape](#) with documentation for \$20 ^[1]. The program takes 16K bytes of [memory](#), and played the [Second West Coast Computer Faire Microcomputer Chess Tournament](#) in March 1978 ^[2].
