The **Uniform-Platform Computer Chess Championship** was initiated and organized by [Don Beal](#) at [Queen Mary and Westfield College](#) of [London](#). There were three editions in the early 90s, using uniform platform [IBM PCs](#) with [MS-DOS](#) operating system. The first two editions had also a [C](#) group, all programs compiled with the same C Compiler and running on identical [workstations](#). All games were played automatically.
