Witchess, (PMess, Npmess, NPMchess) a private chess engine by [Mridul Muralidharan](#), presumably successor or branch of his experimental [MessChess](#) program. Witchess played a strong [CCT7](#), the [CCT8](#) under the handle **PMess** (parallel Mess) ^[1], and the [CCT9](#) as **NPMchess** ^[2]. At [ICC](#), Witchess is known under the handle **Npmess**, applying a [parallel search](#), so far on a dual core [AMD](#) processor ^[3].
