**Z-Chess**,

an early microcomputer chess program written by [Bill Miller](#) for the [Z80](#) based [TRS-80](#) Model 1, released in the late 70s and early 80s by [Adventure International](#). Z-Chess had 7 levels of play to search up to 6 plies deep and could manage both [castling](#) and [en passant](#) <sup>[1]</sup>.
